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


Indications

Children (<16y) sustaining major trauma requiring emergency transfer from South East Scotland Trauma Units to the Paediatric Major Trauma Centre (MTC)

Not to be used for non-urgent trauma transfers, or non-trauma transfers.

Pathways



involve paramedics, local TU team or ScotSTAR team.

Single System Patient with stable single-system injuries and no critical care requirements during transfer (actual or potential) Call Paediatric Major Trauma Centre (PMTC) Single Point of Contact (SPOC): 0131 312 0958 (24/7) Pass details on patient injury, clinical needs and any specialty requirements PMTC SPOC will activate PMTC in-house trauma team ± specialists to receive the patient in Emergency Department (ED) Resus as clinically indicated Call SAS NOW line stating emergency paediatric trauma transfer to ED Resus in South East PMTC:
