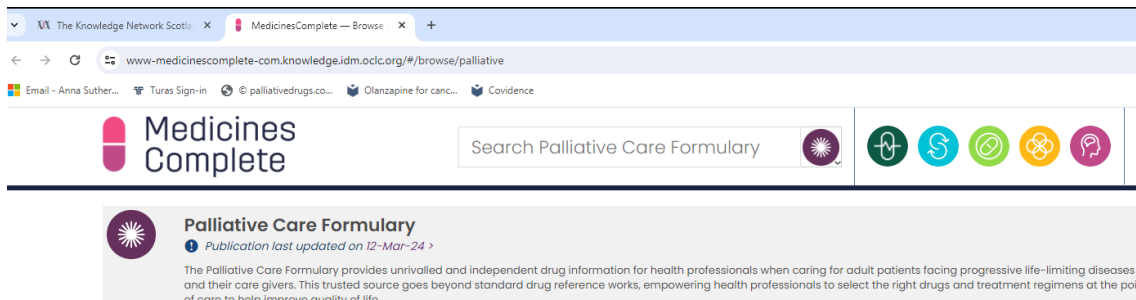

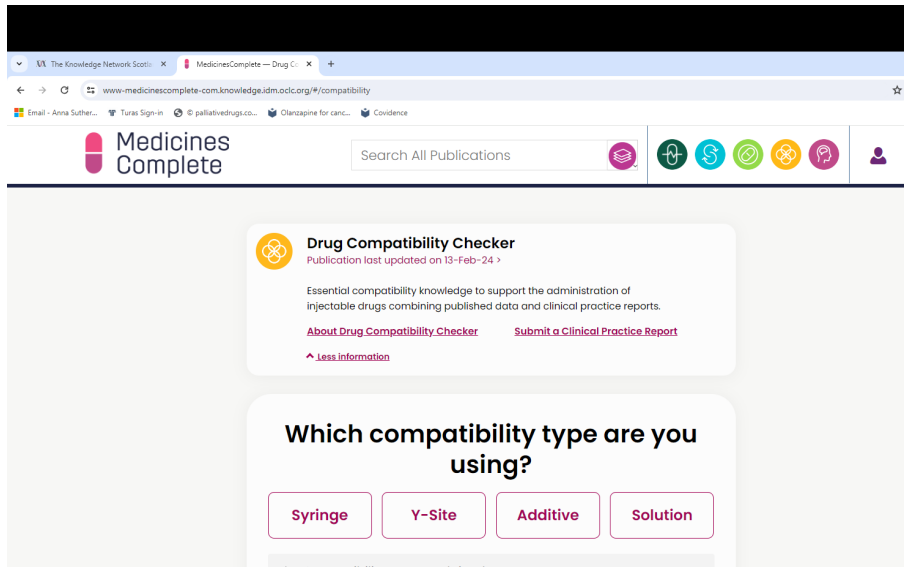
Select the resource you require, such as "Palliative Care Formulary", wait a moment and the PCF will launch

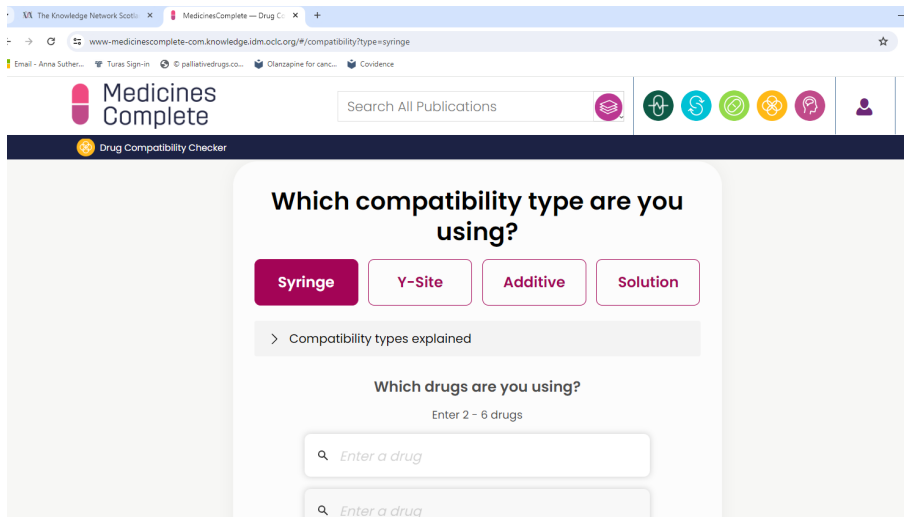
You are now in the PCF. If you require the compatibility checker, select the orange circle with 4 interlocking white circles inside on the top right banner

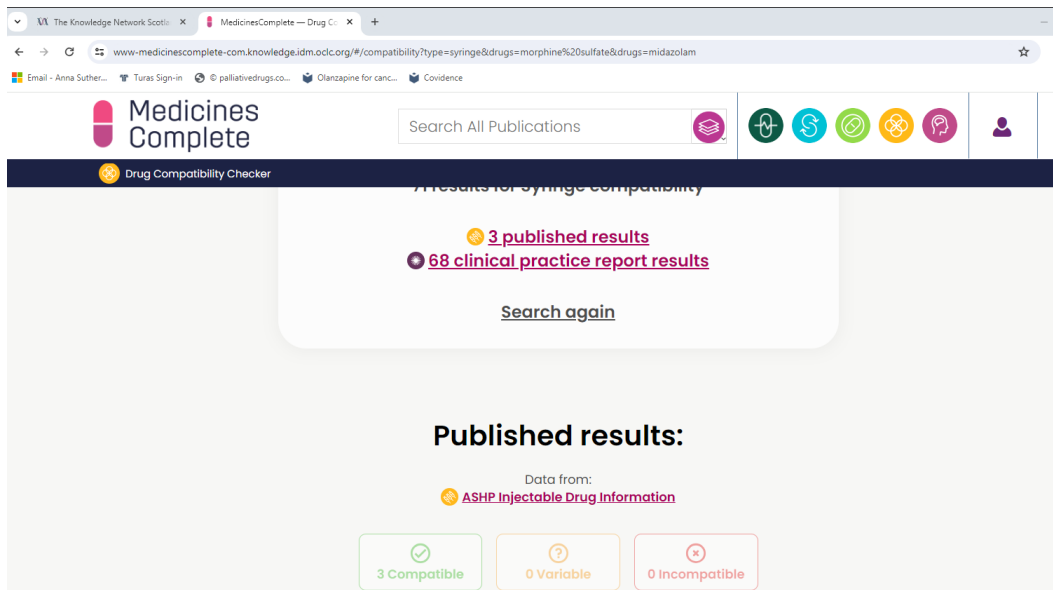


The Drug Compatibility Checker will launch

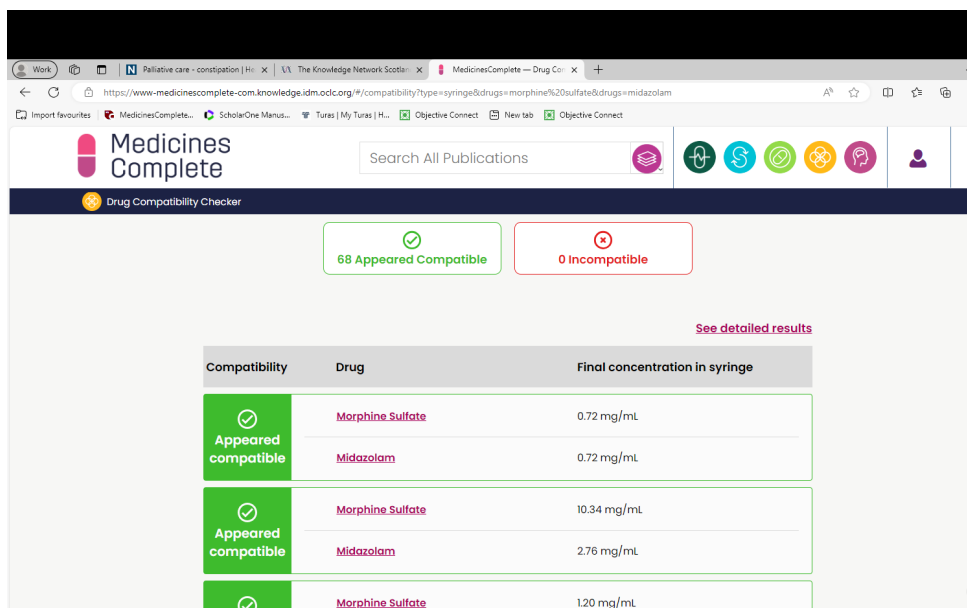


Select "Syringe" and type in the medications you are wanting to check, up to 6 drugs can be entered, scroll down and click "submit"
